
Cradled by hills draped in gorgeous oak and pine forests, the sacred Naukuchiatal lake is no less than heaven on Earth! Hugging its pristine banks and prettily ensconced in a wooded ridge, stands the Lake Resort Naukuchiatal, a secret spot of serenity! The resort sits amidst a 70-acre wild oak forest that is home to about 135 species of birds, rendering it a paradise for birdwatchers. Every part of the property blends with the forest - be it the comfortable wood-lined cottages; the well-equipped tents; an openair lakeside viewing deck where meals can be served; a multi-cuisine restaurant that offers one of the best coffees in the hills; or the forested pathways winding through it.

WHAT TO DO

Go for forest walks and discover villages with quaint temples and fragrant orchards. Find your trekking route or be led by a trained guide! If you love butterflies, request for a trip to a research centre that houses one of India's largest butterfly collections.

Naukuchiatal is around 320 km from Delhi and 65 km from Pantnagar airport.

NEARBY

Nainital and Sattal are about 28 km and 17 km away, respectively, and Bhimtal, about 10 km.
